

The Rebuilding Hope Inc SOS Leadership Team met February 25 and voted to cancel the normal SOS21 with hopes to offer a normal SOS22 next summer. In its place we are offering a modified SOS experience that we are calling SOS Special Edition.



How will this year be like SOS that I know?

- **The Mission** – Our goal is still to be Servants on Site showing the love of Christ to our communities.
- **The Project** – Rebuilding Hope will provide projects, materials, and any leadership needed. Initial materials will be on site Monday morning as in the past & any additional materials needed will be delivered by runners as requested.
- **Local Church Partners** – Each project - homeowner & crew - will be supported by a local church partner.
- **Ratio of adults to youth** – One male adult for every 5 male youth. One female adult for every 5 female youth.

How will it be different this year?

- **Groups** – SOS Special Edition will be conducted on a group-by-group basis. A church or organization is free to bring a group and work on a project during a given week. The group will remain together as one group, not splitting up across other groups. There may be more than one group working on projects at any given time though they will NOT be working together.
- **Theme** – Rather than offering a standard theme like we would for an entire camp, we want to give groups the opportunity to choose a theme/focus tailored to their group.
- **Housing** - Rebuilding Hope will make arrangements for housing for out-town groups from Sunday evening through Saturday morning. Local groups will return to their homes each evening or make their own arrangements.
- **Devotions** – Because you know your group best, we would encourage you to bring appropriate devotion materials; however Rebuilding Hope can help provide materials if requested in advance.
- **Worship** – Evening worship will not be in large corporate gatherings but with each individual church group. Groups leaders will have the option of taking ownership for their worship times. or requesting local speakers. This is a great opportunity for your own group retreat. Guest speakers and musicians may be available upon request in advance.
- **Meals** – There will be no large group meals. Lunches will be provided by the church partnering with the project. Two or more groups serving the same week will have their other meals at different locations or at the same location but at different times. Meal specifics for out-of-town groups will be communicated by Rebuilding Hope.
- **Registration Fee** –Total registration fee for anyone attending SOS Special Edition is \$25 for the week.

How can I register my group?

- Choose a couple of options from the available weeks listed below
- Identify any experienced roof or ramp builders within your group who would be willing to serve as crew chiefs for your crews.

 - Your 1st and 2nd choice of a week to attend.
 - Names and contact information for potential crew chiefs.
- After the dates for the week have been agreed on, total registration fee for group at \$25 each will be expected within 2 weeks.
