Long-serving dump body finds third life on donated truck

A donated box truck and a long-serving dump truck body have found new life together at Rebuilding Hope.

Twelve years ago, the ministry purchased a truck with the dump body. When the motor blew up after six years, the ministry purchased another truck and put the dump body on it. The second truck, after another six years, needed replacing.

Meanwhile, Central Baptist Church planned to dispose of a box truck that was equipped with a stage bed. Instead of selling the truck, the church donated it to Rebuilding Hope.

Once volunteers using two forklifts removed the stage bed, the dump body found its next home on the chassis of the donated truck.

Side panels with the Rebuilding Hope logo were added.

Fund-raising Campaign Begun to Repair Pavement Around Rebuilding Hope

Rebuilding Hope has begun a campaign to raise up to \$100,000 to repair the paved area around the building at 414 Raleigh Road.

Wear and tear over the years have left the 35,190-square-foot area with potholes and bare of asphalt. The resurfacing is needed to prevent damage to vehicles and allow proper drainage away from the building.
